



2016 Summit Rimfire Challenge Rules

1. The target for both youth and adults is the A 23/5 50 Yard Smallbore Rifle Target as shown.
2. 5 Shots per bull and 4 scoring bulls for a maximum score of 200, 20x. Rounds in the sighting bull do not count for score unless they fall below the sighting bull line.
3. Allowable firearms include any (pistol or rifle) using a rimfire-based cartridge. This includes 22 short, 22 long, 22 long rifle, 22 WMR, 17 HM2, and 17 HMR rounds.
4. Adult Division targets are mounted at 50 yards. Youth Division targets are mounted at 25 yards. Any safe and stable shooting position is allowed. Lead sleds prohibited.
5. One competitor can shoot multiple targets, but each target must be shot by only one competitor. Multiple firearms per target are allowed.
6. Hits cutting or touching the scoring ring receive the higher score.
7. Hits outside the outer scoring ring receive a value of zero.
8. If more than 20 hits are found on paper below and not touching the sighting bull line, the scores of the 20 lowest value hits below the sighting bull line are recorded for score.
9. Each target must be completed within one 20 minute range session. An additional 5 minutes will be allowed if necessary.
10. Scoring decisions by the judges are final.



11. Last round of fire and target sale at 11:30 AM. Awards ceremony held approx. 12:15 PM. These times subject to change to accommodate overflow.
12. SRA Board Members and Volunteer RSO's are not eligible to compete for trophies and/or prizes. However, family members are welcome to participate.
13. Participants need not be present at the awards ceremony to win. An email or phone number is requested upon target purchase for those participants who may not be present at the awards ceremony.
