Minutes  
Board of Directors Meeting  
12 April 2023

*Meeting Convened*

Time: 18:29 (Summit County Senior Center, County Commons, Frisco, CO)

Present: Tom Kroenke, Dan Bjork, Tom Little, Mike Bohlender, Mike May, Arnie Yuen, Aaron Byrne, Rob Hoffman, and Kat Gray.

*Regular Agenda Items*

Secretary's Report. After action items were reviewed and appropriate items closed, the BoD approved the March 2023 minutes.

Treasurer's Report. The BoD approved the Treasurer's monthly report.

March total income was \$286 and was received through Amazon donations.

Expenses of \$1,448 were comprised of \$1,346 for maintenance and supplies, \$80 in business expenses, \$22 in bank service charges, and \$1 in Paypal fees.

Totals show a net loss of \$1,162 for the month of March, and a YTD net loss of \$1,421.

Total current assets are \$11,601 with approximately \$10,479 remaining in the operating account.

Rangemaster's Report. The BoD approved the Rangemaster's monthly report.

Documented visitors totaled 0 in March.

RSOs volunteered a total of 0 hours of RSO shifts this month.

The range has been closed since 19 September 2022 for the sound mitigation project.

*BoD Agenda – Completed Action Items*

- Additional donation boxes (Dan) – The current cash donation vaults will be monitored to see if the new sound mitigation infrastructure affects their usage. After the range has been re-opened for a while, and donation patterns can be compared to previous years, the need for additional boxes will be re-evaluated.

*BoD Agenda – Ongoing Action Items*



- Shooting Range Prescribed Burn (Kathleen Gray, USFS) – A 44-acre prescribed burn has been approved by the USFS for the area adjacent to the shooting range. Ground preparation is the first step in the process and will occur this summer with the actual burn occurring next spring --when conditions are optimal. Requiring a one-day range closure, the USFS Road Crew will need access to the range to create a permanent dozer line this summer when they are in the area. Additionally, on 13 & 15 June 2023 Summit Fire and Red White and Blue will be using the range area for fire scenario training and will require range closures for these days.
- Basic Instructor Training (BIT) and NRA CCW Instructor Training class, 27-28 May 2023 in Colorado Springs (Tom L) – BIT is scheduled for 26 May and the CCW Instructor course is being held on 27-28 May. Spaces are filling up and those interested are encouraged to register before the 18 April deadline.
- Pistol Course, 24 June 2023 in Granby (Tom L) – This course will not be taught by the SRA this year.
- Other 2023 Firearms Courses (Tom L) -- An NRA Basic Pistol class has been proposed for 22 or 23 June at a cost of \$150 per person for a minimum of 8 students. An NRA Women on Target (WoT) class has been proposed for 17 June.
- Range Re-opening / Mitigation Update (Dan) – Aaron B, on behalf of the County, provided an update on these projects. Work on the range continues to progress towards completion and it is projected that the range will be ready to re-open later this month. The lead mitigation project, contracted by the County with MT2, will occur this spring. It is hopeful that the lead mitigation project can be done concurrently with the USFS fire mitigation project -- minimizing range closures. Additionally, air quality testing inside the range's semi-enclosures will be conducted by MT2 prior to the range re-opening.
- Range Clean-up Prior to Re-opening (Tom L) – 28 April has been proposed for a range clean-up day, with 29 April being used to perform the air quality study. 30 April is the current estimated date for re-opening of the range to the public.
