*Meeting Convened*

*Regular Agenda Items*

Secretary's Report. After action items were reviewed and appropriate items closed, the BoD approved the April 2023 minutes.

Treasurer's Report. The BoD approved the Treasurer's monthly report.

April total income was \$370 and was received through Kroger donations and vault proceeds.

Expenses of \$1,630 were comprised of \$93 for maintenance and supplies, \$239 in business expenses, \$1,275 for instructor training, and \$22 in bank service charges.

Totals show a net loss of \$1,260 for the month of April, and a YTD net loss of \$2,681.

Total current assets are \$10,341 with approximately \$9,245 remaining in the operating account.

Rangemaster's Report. The BoD approved the Rangemaster's monthly report.

Documented visitors totaled 0 in April.

RSOs volunteered a total of 0 hours of RSO shifts this month.

The range, after being closed since 19 September 2022 for the sound mitigation project, has re-opened 06 May 2023.

*BoD Agenda – Completed Action Items*

- Range Workday, 05 May 2023 (Merle) – Merle Schultz, Thekla Schultz, Tom Kroenke, Tom Little, Mike May, Mike Bohlender, Mike Green, and Scott Meyer cumulatively volunteered 24 hours preparing the range for re-opening.

*BoD Agenda – Ongoing Action Items*



- Range Re-Opening: Status and Work Remaining to be Done (Merle) – With great excitement, as of 06 May, the range has re-opened. Adapting to the new infrastructure will require observational analysis of guest behaviors and a solution-based focus to maximize guest safety and enjoyment.
- Firefighter Training above Shooting Range on 13, 15, and 22 June 2023: Range Closure (Tom K) – These dates will require full-day range closures to provide a safe training environment for our local firefighters.
- MT2 Lead Exposure Study and Lead Mitigation: Status (Dan) – The lead exposure study is being scheduled in June – possibly the same week as the firefighter training. Scheduling for the lead mitigation project remains pending.
- Basic Instructor Training (BIT), 26 May 2023, and NRA CCW Instructor Training Class, 27-28 May 2023 in Colorado Springs (Tom L) -- Merle and Tom L are attending these classes on behalf of the SRA.
- 2023 Firearms Courses (Tom L) -- A WoT class has been officially scheduled for 17 June. A Basic Pistol Course has been tentatively scheduled for 08 July.
- Social Media Facebook Communications (Mike B) – To ensure that the SRA's social media platforms are providing up-to-date information it was proposed to assign the Assistant Range Master with the responsibility of maintaining communications with our social media coordinator, Ron. Until this responsibility is officially delegated, Tom K has accepted responsibility for this task.

- Dan has connections with a CPR Certification Instructor and is gauging interest in organizing a class. The cost would be \$80/person, with a date yet to be determined.
