Meeting Convened

Time: 18:32 (Summit County Senior Center, County Commons, Frisco, CO)

Regular Agenda Items

Secretary's Report. After action items were reviewed and appropriate items closed, the BoD approved the June 2023 minutes.

Treasurer's Report. The BoD approved the Treasurer's monthly report.

June total income was \$1,453.51 and was received through Paypal and June WoT class registrations.

Expenses of \$1,436.69 were comprised of \$159 for maintenance and supplies, \$386 in business expenses, \$22 in bank service charges, \$810 for the June WoT class, \$56 for RSO training, and \$4 in Paypal fees.

Totals show a net income of \$17 for the month of June, and a YTD net loss of \$3,449.

Total current assets are \$9,573 with approximately \$8,193 remaining in the operating account.

Rangemaster's Report. The BoD approved the Rangemaster's monthly report.

Documented visitors totaled 406 in June. Counted patrons totaled 331 on the weekends and 75 on weekdays.

RSOs volunteered a total of 57.5 hours of RSO shifts this month comprised of 46.5 hours on weekends and 11 hours on weekdays.

Joe Ortiz has volunteered to help weld damaged target frames.

BoD Agenda – Completed Action Items



- Firefighter Training above Shooting Range on 15 and 22 June 2023 — Range Closure (Merle) – The range was staffed by RSO volunteers during all of these sessions, ensuring a safe environment for the training.
- WoT Class, 24 June 2023 (Tom L) -- The well-organized class ran smoothly and received praise from the students for the quality of the classroom instruction.

BoD Agenda – Ongoing Action Items

- Range Re-Opening: Status and Work Remaining to be Done (Merle)– Some of the target stands are in need of repair or replacement. Merle will coordinate the scheduling of a clean-up workday. Three new RSO's are being scheduled for training. Help with restocking consumables at the range is needed, especially during the week. Merle will source the materials needed for repairing the rifle stands.
- MT2 Lead Exposure Study and Lead Mitigation: Status (Dan)– Scheduling for these projects remains ongoing and no new updates have been received.
- BPC Class, 15 July 2023 (Tom L) – Three students are registered for this course. Three shooting bays on the pistol range will need to be reserved for this class starting at 1330.
- Other 2023 Firearms Courses (Tom L) -- Another WoT class is being considered for later in the year, depending on interest.
- Social Media Facebook Communications (Mike B) – Ron, as our Facebook coordinator, plans to align the website's content with our social media platforms. It was discussed that increased advertising for our classes may increase attendance-- and possibly donations.
- US Law Shield Representatives (Lisa T. / Joshua C.)— A company providing “legal defense for self-defense” presented the details of their services.

Additional Business

- Following a motion, and a second, a vote affirmed discussing the sound levels inside of the shooting bays with the County.
- The generator is scheduled for service on 13 July.
- The range toilet needs to be serviced.

- An inquiry from the Facebook page looking for a “king range coach” contacted Merle who verified that the SRA does not have such a coach.
- Multiple guests shared their appreciation of the SRA’s volunteers for their contributions to the local range.
